Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to all our Riverbank families and a special warm welcome to those students and their families who are joining our school community. We hope you enjoy a long and happy association with our school. We take pride in setting high expectations of our students who are the very centre of our structured learning environment. Our Restorative Practice philosophy provides a framework for building strong relationships, effective communication, personal and social responsibility and a sense of belonging.

Education in a changing world has a vital role to play in preparing students for successful, enriched lives. At Riverbank Public School, students are challenged, yet nurtured and work both independently and in groups to solve authentic problems. Learning includes partnerships with industries in order to develop skills in students of innovation, fair testing and experimentation. Students accumulate a strong repertoire of general capabilities including literacy, numeracy, creative and critical thinking, intercultural understanding, ethical understanding, information and communication technologies as well as personal and social responsibilities.

Students, staff, parents and community members are encouraged to participate in all aspects of school life. Parents are valued as true partners in the education of their children, contributing their initiative, energy, time and expertise to the school. At Riverbank, all students have the opportunity to attain knowledge, skills, values and attitudes enabling them to be reflective, self-sufficient and self-motivated lifelong learners.

This year we have formed 74 mainstream classes and 3 support classes for students with special needs.

- 11 Early Stage 1 Kindergarten
- 23 Stage 1 Years 1 and 2
- 21 Stage 2 Years 3 and 4
- 19 Stage 3 Years 5 and 6

The first few days of a new school year are always a little hectic; as students learn new routines and parents are keen to find out what class their children are in and where they line up. I have been very impressed with how settled the students have been in their new classrooms.

Our main entry gate will be open from 8.15am to 8.45am and then from 2.45pm to 3pm. During 8.45am and 2.45pm, there is an intercom at the main entry for parents to access the school. The High School have their own gates on Wentworth Street, located near their car park. After consultation with the P&C and in line with current COVID guidelines, we are continuing with no parents on site in the morning, with students to be dropped off at our school gates. Parents are welcome on school grounds of an afternoon to collect their child.

Kindergarten parents will be welcome on site in the mornings for the first week (Monday 1 to Friday 5 February). From Monday 8 February, Year 6 students will support Kindergarten walking to their classrooms from the school gates.

We request parents leave the school grounds promptly after dropping or picking up their child.

Before and After school care have their own gates on Wentworth Street from 6.30am to 8.15am and then from 2.45pm to 6.30pm

A list with class names, teachers and a school map will be included in next week's school newsletter and will be placed on our website and school app. Our 2021 School Information Booklet is now available on our school website.

2021 school invoices will be sent out each term. The Term 1 invoice has been included in the welcome pack.

All students have a wonderful opportunity to participate in weekly Chess, Dance, Choir, Band, Music, Music tuition, Drama, ICT, Debating and PSSA sport programs. An overview of paid after school activities will be sent out on the school app next week.

I have included in the welcome pack our 2021 Term 1 Calendar, which highlights key events throughout the term. Dates may sometimes vary, and new events will be added. The calendar is available on the school's website. This year we have a parent engagement calendar which highlights key events and workshops.

Meet the Teacher information evening sessions will be held during weeks 3, 4 and week 5. These sessions will be held online. We have scheduled a classroom visit time for parents to come on site and meet their teacher in person. More information will be sent home regarding meet the teacher sessions. Individual student learning will be discussed at parent - teacher interviews in Week 9. Parents are welcome to make a time to meet with their teacher either over the phone or a meeting after school. Please email the school to request an appointment after the online information sessions.

Newsletters are published during even weeks and regular updates are sent out through our school app. Our Facebook page celebrates our weekly achievements.

Late Drop off and Early Pick Up - If you are picking up your child early, you must go to the school office and sign them out before you collect your child from the classroom. If a student is late arriving to school, you must sign them in at the front office before they go to class. Students cannot sign themselves in or out of school.

The school's Kiss and Ride area is within the "No Parking" zones and are located on Wentworth Street and Riverbank Drive. You are only allowed to stop your vehicle to set down or pick up passengers and must not stop for more than 2 minutes. The driver must not be more than 3 metres from the vehicle. Highway patrol will be regularly patrolling our perimeter. Thank you for ensuring the safety of all of our students when entering and leaving the premises.

At Riverbank, we value open communication channels in our school. You are more than welcome to make an appointment to meet with me by contacting the School Administration Staff. Alternatively, I am in the playground or on front gate duty most mornings and afternoons and I always welcome feedback.

#### It was with much excitement that we welcomed your child on their first day of primary school today!

Our Kindergarten teachers are looking forward to getting to know the children in their class and meeting each child's family. We understand that starting school is a big step for children and their parents/caregivers who may find this time overwhelming. We will endeavour to provide you with the necessary information to ensure the transition to Kindergarten occurs smoothly.

#### **Kindergarten Classes**

To assist students as they learn their new class name and peers, we have allocated each class an animal name. This corresponds to the name tag students are going to wear at school over the first few weeks. You will see an animal sign in each Kindergarten class window.

#### **School Drop Off Procedures**

From Week 2, Wednesday 3 February until Friday 5 February, Kindergarten students will go directly to their classrooms of a morning. School begins at 8.45am, however Kindergarten teachers will be supervising students in classrooms between 8.15am and 8.45am. This provides a familiar environment for children as they adjust to school. Parents are welcome to drop their child to their classroom during Week 2.

Parents will drop their child at either the front or back school gates from Week 3, Monday 8 February till Friday 12 February, and Year 6 students will escort them to their classes. We ask that you try to make goodbyes brief. Staff will be there to support your child should they become upset. If your child attends Northwest Community Before School Care, they will be walked to their classroom by one of the carers. From Week 4, Monday 15 February, Kindergarten students will put their bags in class lines near the flagpole and join the Year 1-6 students in the playground from 8.15am. When the bell rings at 8.45am, they are to line up by the flagpoles to meet their class teacher. All classes will be practising this prior to Week 4 to ensure students are familiar with routines and expectations.

#### **Lunch & Recess Times**

For the first two weeks of school, Kindergarten students will be having recess and lunch time in a designated area supported by a higher ratio of staff. This procedure plays an important role in supporting students as they learn about the school playground, understand the school expectations and develop friendships amongst their Kindergarten peers.

#### **School Pick Up Procedures**

Students will be collected from classrooms at 2.30pm until the end of Week 3, Friday 12 February. From Week 4, Monday 15 February, pickup will be at 2.45pm in line with the rest of the school. **Kindergarten students are to be collected from their classrooms.** Prior to 2.45pm, teachers will be assisting students to pack up and prepare for home time. Teachers will instruct students and give clear instructions, ready for pick up when the bell rings. Parents will be invited to the room, normally one at a time at the beginning of the year as we start to learn faces. It is very important that we know who is collecting each child every day. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation in making this a safe and settled way to end the school day. As this can be a very busy time in the room, if you have questions to ask your teacher, please wait until all the students have been collected before having a one-on-one chat so that we can give you our full attention. If your child attends Northwest Community After School Care, they will be collected by one of the carers.

#### **Your child's Daily Pick Up Routines**

Please complete the weekly overview attached to today's welcome letter and return it to your child's teacher as soon as possible. This allows teachers to be aware of who your child will be picked up by each day and if they are attending Before or After School Care. If there is a change to routine, please contact the office by phone or email and the class teacher will be informed.

#### **Teaching and Learning**

**English** - Students will be immersed in quality literature and be provided with structured, interactive activities that enable them to develop confidence, skills and strategies as early readers and composers. They will learn to express themselves, think creatively and respond to a variety of texts, by sharing their own perspectives about the ideas conveyed throughout the text. Students will develop their understanding of concepts of print, but will also have opportunities to explore the role of the author in a variety of texts.

**Mathematics** - Students will develop early arithmetical strategies to count, combine and separate numbers as they learn basic addition and subtraction strategies. They will explore 2D space, 3D objects, patterns and algebra, position, length, statistics and probability, volume and capacity, area and time.

Science – Weather Watchers

History – Families Past and Present

Personal Development – Who am I?

Sport – Fundamental movement skills

RFF – STEAM and Library

#### **Meet the Teacher Night**

The Kindergarten teachers are looking forward to getting to know the students in their class and meetings each child's family. A 'Meet the Teacher' information session has been organised for **Monday 22 February** between 5.30pm and 6.30pm. This is a great opportunity for you to find out more about our routines and the fabulous programs we are offering our students. A letter will be sent home with more information closer to the date. At this stage, the session will be held via Zoom.

#### **School Uniforms**

Please ensure that all items of clothing, including school bags, food containers and drink bottles are clearly labelled with your child's name. This will ensure that missing items are returned to the rightful owner. As all of the children use

the 'Riverbank PS' school bag, it is advised that a bag tag or key chain is attached to your child's bag, so that they can easily identify it. Students are required to wear their **sport uniform on Tuesday and Thursday.**

Kindergarten Homework and Home Reading will begin from Week 5. We look forward to discussing how you can best support your child's progress at home during our 'Meet the Teacher' evening.

#### **Additional Learning Needs & Medical Information**

If your child requires additional learning support, please make sure you let the teacher know so that a plan can be put into place to assist them. Each plan will be different, so it is important to provide us with as much information as possible so that we can have a comprehensive understanding of your child's needs.

If your child has allergies or other medical conditions, please come and see the classroom teacher as soon as possible. Action Plans for students with allergies or asthma, **developed in consultation with your family doctor**, are essential. We encourage families to avoid bringing peanut products to school. We thank you for your cooperation and ask that children not share food at school.

#### **Birthdays**

Birthdays are special occasions for children and they love to share this celebration with their peers. Students may bring cupcakes or doughnuts for the class on their birthday. Alternatively, a 'Birthday Bucket' may be purchased from the school canteen which your child can share with their peers.

#### **Riverbank Public School Seesaw Policy 2021**

#### **General Statement**

"Seesaw" is an online tool used at Riverbank Public School to create a personalised learning journal for each student. It captures aspects of a students' learning progress that happen throughout the school year. It gives students a voice, makes their thinking visible and encourages self-reflection and ownership of their education. Seesaw empowers students to independently document what they are learning. This app supports the development capabilities in communication, collaboration, creative thinking, problem solving, digital Literacy and citizenship. It strengthens the link between home and school and provides students with an authentic audience, as parents are able to access the app to keep up to date with class events, activities and learning. Seesaw's platform allows families to celebrate their child's learning development, progress and achievements, as they occur.

#### How will Seesaw be used at Riverbank Public School?

Teachers and students K-2 will use school iPads to post work samples, photos, videos and voice recordings to personalised student portfolios. Students will only begin to use Seesaw after written consent is received from the parent/carer. The frequency and content of students' work posted, will occur consistently across each grade and depend on year level and curriculum. Parents/carers will be able to see their child's work throughout the year and comment on their progress. Students will also have the opportunity to share and discuss their portfolio with their parent/carer through events organised at school. At the end of the school year parents/carers will have a limited time to download a copy of their child's learning journal.

#### **Parent Posting Expectations**

- Parents and Carers can like posts and comment on their child's portfolio.
- Parents and Carers comments are to be approved by the teacher.
- Parents and Carers comments are to celebrate and acknowledge student learning.
- Parents and Carers are not to use the images/videos for any other use.
- Parents and Carers will use this platform to increase involvement in their child's learning.
- Parents and Carers are encouraged to ask questions that show interest in their child's learning, providing opportunities to reflect and connect together using the Seesaw portfolio.
- Parents and Carers are encouraged to give positive feedback and praise. Examples of what
  this includes are praise or feedback for effort, progress, resilience, consistency, creativity and
  presentation.
- Parents and Carers must use the communication of this platform only to support and celebrate student learning.
- Direct communication with teachers is to go through the school email or teacher's email.
