Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Riverbank Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Riverbank Public School to accommodate the growing student population in the area. The project will deliver 15 new flexible teaching spaces, a covered outdoor learning area (COLA), additional student amenities, shade structures and an extension of administration and staff facilities

Progress summary

Work is progressing well, with the new COLA, extensions to the administration building and all structural works on the new building completed. A new carpark for staff is close to completion, and work is underway on the new sunshade.

New pedestrian crossing

Work will soon start on the new pedestrian crossing closer to the temporary entrance – near 18 Wentworth Street.

Next steps

During the September/October school holidays, work will continue on the new sunshade and the roof will be installed on the walkway which extends from the new COLA to the administration building.

Work is also continuing on the new building, including installation of all services, in readiness for work to start on the internal fit-out.
