Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Riverbank Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Riverbank Public School to accommodate the growing student population in the area. The project will deliver 15 new flexible teaching spaces, a covered outdoor learning area, additional student amenities, shade structures and an extension of administration and staff facilities.

Progress summary

Development application

We expected the Development Application (DA) to be approved at the end of September or early October.

We are working closely with Blacktown City Council on the DA. Council asked us to consider a number of issues and we have been working together to ensure the best outcome and minimise impact to open space and play areas. We expect to receive DA approval by the end of October and construction work will commence shortly afterwards.

We still expect to complete the upgrade by early 2020.
